The noun jam may be used in different contexts with completely different meanings. In food-related contexts, it indicates a sweet paste made out of fruit also known as jelly. The verb to jam means putting something into a space that is too small for it. For example, you would jam a week's worth of clothes into a small suitcase. A traffic jam is when too many cars are jammed in a road too small for them, such as during the rush hour (that is, the moment when people knock off work). Finally, a jam session is a musical event, process, or activity where musicians play (i.e. "jam") by improvising without extensive preparation or predefined arrangements.
