



Landmark #19 Santa's Village Finland





Rovaniemi is the Official Hometown of Santa Claus, an attraction that draws more than 300'000 annual visitors from all over the world. Santa Claus' original home lies in the mysterious Korvatunturi ("Ear Fell") in Finnish Lapland. Since the exact location is a secret only revealed to a chosen few, Santa made up his mind to establish an office open to the public in Rovaniemi, the capital of Lapland, in 1985. Rovaniemi received the status of the Official Hometown of Santa Claus in 2010. As probably the most famous person on the planet, Santa Claus is well aware of his global influence and the huge responsibility that comes with it: "I'm an ambassador of good will, love and peace, and wish nothing but happiness to the people of the world".
